

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE

RELATING TO FEES AND CHARGES FOR USE OF PARKS AND RECREATION FACILITIES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the People of the City and County of Honolulu:

SECTION 1. Purpose and intent. The purpose of this ordinance is to establish camping fees.

SECTION 2. Chapter 10, Article 2, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 1990, is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated by the revisor of ordinances and to read as follows:

Sec. 10-2. Fees for Camping.

The following fees shall be assessed for use of campsites:

\$5.00 per day for campsites holding up to 5 people.

\$10.00 per day for campsites holding up to 10 people.

\$75.00 per day for campsites holding up to 60 people.

\$125.00 per day for campsites holding up to 100 people.

\$312.50 per day for campsites holding up to 250 people.

Proceeds from the fees assessed under this section shall be deposited in the camping revenue account in the general fund and shall be used to improve and maintain city campsites.

An additional fee of \$2.00 per permit issued shall be assessed to pay for the administrative costs associated with the issuance of the permit. The monies from this fee shall be deposited in the general fund. A permit shall be valid for one or more consecutive days.
