You must be a club member to enter and be eligible for prizes. A limit of 5 pictures per individual membership or 7 pictures per family membership applies.

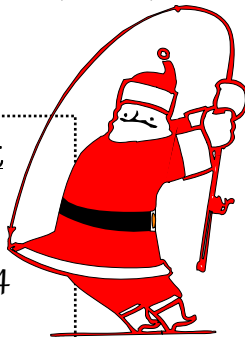


Grab Bag

It is up to each individual to assess the conditions prior to launching according to his/her experience and ability, and to decide whether to participate or not.
- A paddle will be cancelled by the leader(s) when there is a Small Craft Advisory or High Surf Advisory.

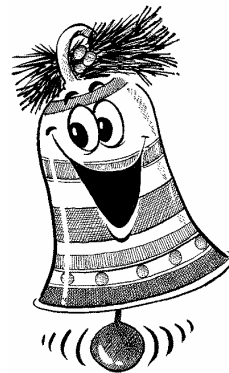
